Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and curing every disease and every sickness. If you are a father or would like to honor one here or elsewhere, pause as you leave worship to accept a candy bar from the greeters. Happy Father's Day!


